

**BAR – Brazilian Administration Review
Transfer of Copyright**

Dear authors:

Brazilian Law 9610, February 19, 1998, regulates copyright issues. We ask authors to read the following items for the transfer of copyright:

1. BAR – Brazilian Administration Review retains, through transfer of copyright, ownership of the rights on any article it publishes.
2. The authors retain their moral rights on the article, including the right to be identified as the authors whenever the article is used in any form.
3. Upon written request from the authors to BAR, BAR will, on its own discretion, authorize or not authorize publication of the article as a chapter or part of a book, or in any other format, as requested by the authors.
4. In spite of transfer of copyright to BAR, the authors retain the right to reuse the article in future collections of their own work without any costs. Recognition of the original publication in BAR is the only obligation in such cases.
5. Authors are granted permission to make photocopies of their articles or distribute them by e-mail or fax if for use by the authors in their own classes and for academic purposes, and provided that (5.1) such copies are not sold or exchanged in any way for financial gains, and (5.2) explicit reference is made to the original source in BAR (as the copyright holder) in all copies of the article.

The authors should complete **Parts A and B** of the form below, sign them, and send the form to BAR, while retaining a copy for themselves. If the authors are not the current copyright holders of the article, only Part A should be completed, and Part C should be completed by the copyright holder.

Upon submitting this article for publication in BAR – Brazilian Administration Review, the authors declare that:

- (a) This is original work of the authors and it has never been published in any other place, format or language (with the exception of academic meetings), and it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.
- (b) This article does not violate copyright or any other right of third parties, it does not contain defamatory or obscene material, and it is not illegal in the authors' home countries, according to Brazilian law, and according to internationally acceptable practices. The authors understand that the authors will be obliged to pay for any damage to Brazilian Administration Review in case the journal incurs losses or expenses (including financial costs and legal fees) as per the authors' fault in observing this agreement.
- (c) The authors have obtained permission to reproduce materials (such as tables and figures) from third parties possibly included in the article, and the authors acknowledge the sources of all those materials.
- (d) If the article discusses parts of a research project that have been previously published elsewhere, including in academic conferences, the article is being published in BAR with significantly different contents. If this is the case, the authors also explicitly acknowledge this fact as an end note.
- (e) The authors are in full agreement with the final version of the article that will be published in BAR and that has been revised for that purpose.
